The purpose of the panel meeting is to build up a consensus evaluation of each of the research grant applications allocated to this panel. Please note that the applications are confidential documents. Regarding impartiality, please let us know if you have any close personal relations, close professional co-operation or competition with any of the applicants.

The Academy of Finland acknowledges the significant commitment of reviewers' time to the peer review process. After the funding decisions have been made and the final results have been communicated to the applicants, the Academy of Finland will publish a list of the names, titles and institutions of all panel members and individual reviewers and used in the call.

The Finnish Act on the Openness of Government Activities applies, among other things, to expert reviews. As such, review reports are confidential documents, but the applicant will receive the review report of their



application, including the names of all members of the panel, after the funding decisions have been made. On request, the (anonymized) draft reviews and the names of the reviewers may also be disclosed.

Costs covered

The Academy will pay a compensation of EUR 920 to a panel member for the 2-day meeting (EUR 1200 for the Chair), and EUR 50 for each draft review submitted prior to the meeting (EUR 75 for a consortium application).

As the review panel meeting will be organized online, there will be no travel arrangements.
