PUBLIC SELECTION FOR ADMISSION TO THE DOCTORAL COURSE IN TRANSLATIONAL AND CLINICAL MEDICINE (DOT22BFYW2), ACADEMIC YEAR 2022/2023, CYCLE XXXVIII ON SITE WITH SCHOLARSHIP FUNDED BY I.N.P.S. IN FAVOR OF CHILDREN AND ORPHANS OF

- EMPLOYEES AND PENSIONERS OF THE PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION ENROLLED IN THE UNITARY MANAGEMENT OF CREDIT AND SOCIAL SERVICES.

- RETIRED USERS OF THE MANAGEMENT OF CIVIL SERVANTS.

Art. 1

Purpose of the initiative

Following an agreement with INPS for the financing of a scholarship for a PhD, referring to the PhD Course in Translational and Clinical Medicine (DOT22BFYW2), Academic Year 2022/2023, Cycle XXXVIII, the University of Molise announces a place with a scholarship, funded by INPS, additional to those funded by the MUR, in favor of the children and orphans of members of the unitary management of credit and social services and retired users of the management of public employees.

Pursuant to art. 5 of the INPS notice, the selection procedures for admission to the doctorate are the responsibility of the proposing University. The ranking of suitable candidates, with an indication of the score obtained, will be transmitted by the University to the Institute, in order to identify those entitled to the scholarship at the end of the relative competition procedure announced by the Institute. The selection by the University of Molise and the publication of the competition documents with the indication of those eligible for INPS scholarships therefore does not give the right to the assignment of the scholarship, which remains in the hands of INPS.

Candidates interested in INPS scholarships, in addition to possessing the requirements referred to in art. 3 of this announcement, must at the time of submission of the application for admission, pursuant to art. 4, compulsorily submit, through the participation procedure, the self-certification in which they declare, pursuant to Presidential Decree 445/2000, to be in possession of the additional requirements required for INPS scholarships, indicated in art. 3 of the [INPS notice](#), and specifically to be a child or orphan of:

- registered with the unitary management of credit and social services;
- retired user of the Public Employees Management

The training course linked to the scholarship financed through the specific action referred to in the INPS notice provides:

- a) a period of study and research in the enterprise from a minimum of six (6) to a maximum of eighteen (12) months;
- b) a period of study and research abroad from a minimum of three (3) to a maximum of six (6) months.

Art. 2

Call for selection

The public selection is announced for qualifications and exams for admission to the PhD Course in Translational and Clinical Medicine (DOT22BFYW2), Academic Year 2022/2023, Cycle XXXVIII, with administrative headquarters at the University of Molise, indicated below.

For the PhD Course listed above, the personal data sheet attached (attachment A) to this announcement - which represents an integral and substantial part - specifies the requirements for admission, the assessable qualifications, the admission methods, the evaluation criteria of the tests, the calendar of the competitive tests, the research topic.

The start date of activities is set at 1 March 2023 and the end date at 28 February 2026.

This announcement has the value of notification at all effects. Any changes, updates or additions will be notified through publication on the UNIMOL web page <https://www2.unimol.it/dottorato/>.

Failure to comply with the rules contained in this announcement will result in exclusion from the competition.

This call for applications is drawn up in Italian and English, in compliance with the provisions of the relevant regulations in force and the University Regulations on PhD programs.

Art. 3

Admission requirements

Those who hold at least one of the following qualifications may participate in the selection, without limitations of citizenship, age, sex, **children and orphans of members of the unitary management of credit and social services and of retired users of the Public Employees Management:**

- a) master's degree, single-cycle master's degree or specialist degree;
- b) degree of the previous system (old system);
- c) similar qualification obtained abroad - recognized as equivalent to the aforementioned second-level academic qualifications, according to the Bologna process or Master Degree level, which gives access to the doctorate in the country of origin, issued by an officially recognized academic institution. Candidates already in possession of the equivalence of the title issued by an Italian University must attach to the application for admission to the competition the relative self-certification (with indication of the extremes of the measure, etc.). The suitability of the foreign qualification is ascertained by the admission commission to the doctoral course, in compliance with the legislation in force in Italy and in the country where the title was issued, as well as treaties or international



agreements on the recognition of qualifications for the continuation of studies. **The assessment of unsuitability of the qualification entails exclusion from the tests.** In particular, for the purposes of this recognition, candidates must attach to the online application any documentation deemed useful for the purposes of the suitability judgment. The online compilation of the application involves the implicit request to ascertain the suitability of the qualification obtained abroad. The evaluation of the qualification will be possible only if, from the documents produced, it will be possible to deduce all the necessary information containing the minimum elements for the evaluation (type of title; normal duration of the course; official name of the academic institution that issues the title; date of achievement of the title; grade / judgment of achievement compared to the scale adopted in the reference higher education system)

as indicated in the personal data sheet of the chosen PhD Course (Annex A) to which reference is made.

Undergraduates can also apply for admission as long as they obtain the title by 28 February 2023 under penalty of forfeiture. Graduating candidates are required to transmit to the Doctorates Sector (email: settoredottorati@unimol.it), by 3 March 2023, the documentation referring to the achievement of the title, as specified in the following art. 4. Such candidates shall be admitted subject to conditions.

Art. 4

Procedures and deadlines for submitting applications for admission to the selection process

La domanda di ammissione alla selezione deve essere presentata **esclusivamente** tramite la procedura *on line* presente sul Portale dello studente al quale si accede dalla homepage del sito <https://www2.unimol.it/> ("Portale dello studente e servizi online"). No paper documentation must be sent to the offices.

The online registration procedure is active from 20 January 2023 and closes at 10.00 a.m. (Italian time) on 13 February 2023. It is therefore recommended to start the process well in advance so as to conclude it by the deadline.

Applications received after the deadline indicated or that are not transmitted in the manner and within the terms of this article will not be considered valid.

On the [student](#) portal of this University the candidate shall:

- 1) if never been registered at this University, submit (from the "[Registrazione](#)" button on the left-hand menu) a new registration, at the end of which the procedure releases new personal keys (username and password) which can be printed from the appropriate function (the [manual containing the instructions for the registration to the Portal](#) is available on the University website);
- 2) if already a registered user, directly perform the *login* by using the personal keys (username and *password*) already in their possession.

Candidates who have already registered and who have lost their access credentials to the Portal can request them - by appointment - from the Student Secretariats (Campobasso, Pesche and Termoli offices) or, if they entered a personal e-mail address during registration which is still active, they can recover them using the "[Recupero Password](#)" function from the homepage of the [Student portal](#): in this case the system will automatically send the credentials to the candidate's personal address.

To **register for the selection**, the candidate (after accessing his/her personal page via the "Login" function and entering his/her credentials) must click on the "Menu" function in the top right-hand corner.

From the "Menu" they shall enter the "Secretariat" area and click on the "Admission tests" function: on this page they will search for the competition they wish to enroll in.

Foreign candidates must also submit their pre-enrolment application via the University portal. The application to participate in the selection process includes all the annexes which form an integral part of it and is drawn up in the form of self-certification, pursuant to Articles 46 and 47 of Presidential Decree 445/2000 and subsequent amendments, and it is valid as such for all legal purposes. The application submitted by the applicant must contain all the elements necessary for assessing the qualification presented and for verifying its accuracy. Failure to include even one element will prevent the qualification from being assessed.

All candidates are admitted subject to verification of the declarations made for being admitted to the selection process announced by the present notice, and to any stage of the selection procedure, even after registration. The University of Molise reserves the right to carry out checks in accordance with art. 71 et seq. of D.P.R. 445 of 228.12.2000. If, following verification of the self-certifications produced, the qualification possessed does not comply with the requirements or the declarations produced are untrue, the University may at any time, by reasoned decision of the Rector, exclude candidates from the selection procedure or from the PhD course, without prejudice to the resulting criminal liability. In this case, should the candidate be excluded after admission to the course, he/she shall also be required to pay compensation for any scholarship payments received.

After the expiry of this call (it will not be allowed to vary or integrate in any way the attachments uploaded to the Portal. Candidates are asked to submit their application online well in advance of the deadline for the competition. It is the candidate's responsibility to check that the computer procedure has been completed correctly. No claims will be accepted in respect of malfunctions of the computer system due to overloading experienced by candidates close to the deadline. The University Administration has no responsibility in case of dispersion of communications, dependent on inaccurate indications of residence, address or e-mail by the aspirant, from failure or late communication of the change of the same, nor for any telematic problems not attributable to the fault of the Administration itself.

Art.5

Candidates with disabilities and candidates with a DSA diagnosis

Selection is organized by taking into account the individual needs of candidates with disabilities, in accordance with Article 16 of Law no. 104/1992 and subsequent amendments and additions, as well as candidates diagnosed with specific learning disabilities (DSA) as per Law no. 170/2010.

Candidates with disabilities or SLD who wish to request aids and/or compensatory measures to take the oral test must make a request by 20 February 2023, by sending via PEC to the following address amministrazione@cert.unimol.it, exclusively from another PEC address, the form available on the website www2.unimol.it.

This form must be accompanied by certification - in the original or in a certified copy on plain paper - issued by the medical board responsible for the area in question attesting to the state of disability or recognized DSA.

Candidates with disabilities or with DSA residing in foreign countries who intend to make use of adaptations must present the legalized certification attesting to their disability or DSA status issued in their country of residence, accompanied by an official translation exclusively in Italian or English.

In consideration of the current emergency situation, which has led to a reduction in the activities of NHS outpatient clinics, applications will be accepted from candidates with a diagnosis of Specific Learning Disorders (DSA), as defined by law no. 170/2010, even when presenting certificates issued more than three years previously or without conformity. In these cases the candidate must document that he/she is waiting for the renewal or certification of conformity by the National Health Service and the University reserves the right to subsequently request the integration of the documentation foreseen therein. Certifications issued by private specialists must in any case be complete and drawn up in accordance with all the requirements defined by the Consensus Conference on Specific Learning Disorders of 2011.

The Service Centre for Disabled Students and Students with ASD will assess the possibility of granting additional time (up to a maximum of 50% more than the time set for the test) and/or the provision of specific aids.

If such aids are not available or are difficult to obtain in time for each admission test, the Service Centre for Disabled Students and Students with ASD will, in consultation with the candidate, propose a reasonable accommodation for the conduct of the admission test.



The Rector's Delegate for student status and disabilities will propose the solution identified to the President of the Commission responsible for carrying out the selection, if already formally appointed, or to the PhD Course Coordinator, who will decide on the matter.

Art. 6 Reasons of exclusion

The submission of the application for admission, according to the procedures referred to in art. 4, involves the acceptance by the candidates of the rules contained in this notice, failure to comply with which will result in exclusion from the competition. Especially:

- failure to meet the requirements of INPS: children and orphans of members of the unitary management of credit and social services and pensioners users of the Public Employees Management, as requested in the forms attached to this announcement;
- failure to submit the research project, where provided (see "Annex A - personal data sheet of the chosen course") entails non-admission and therefore exclusion from the exams;
- the evaluation of unsuitability by the selection board of the academic degree obtained abroad, entails exclusion from the tests.
- If the documentation produced does not clearly show the duration of the academic course of study and/ or the eligibility of the foreign qualification for access to the doctorate in the country of reference or the scale of value to which the degree and exam scores refer, the Selection Board may refuse admission to the tests or not evaluate the degree or exam score;
- failure to submit to the oral exam will be considered as a waiver of the competition.
- For identification and under penalty of exclusion from the competition, candidates, before the interview begins, must show the identity document, preferably the same as indicated during the admission phase.

Art. 7 Selection Committees

The Jury will be appointed by the Rector with his own Decree published in the University Register, it will be announced after the deadline of the call.

The Jury will be composed of three effective members and as many substitutes, chosen among University Professors and Researchers of the sector or of the competition or scientific disciplinary sectors covered by the Course, also from other Italian and foreign universities.

The Jury will not send any personal communication to the candidates regarding the outcome of the competitive examinations: it will be the sole responsibility of the candidates to inform them through the procedures described in art. 8 of this announcement.

Art. 8 Evaluation criteria and admission tests

In the personal data sheet relating to the doctoral course and attached to this announcement (attachment A) - integral parts of the same and to which reference is made in full - the evaluation criteria, the scores reserved for the evaluation of the qualifications, the project proposal and the oral exam, the dates, times and location of the exam are indicated: This publication is valid as an official notification for all legal purposes.

The Commission has, for the evaluation of each candidate, one hundred points, the assignment of which is regulated by what is indicated in the description of the Doctoral Course - attached A to the announcement - to which reference is made in full.

For the PhD Course, if indicated in the relevant form, a minimum score threshold may be provided for access to the oral exam. In case of failure to achieve the minimum score in the evaluation of qualifications and project proposal (where applicable), candidates will not be admitted to the oral exam.

The presence of candidates is not required during the evaluation of qualifications and the project proposal.

The list of candidates admitted to the interview, with indication of the score relating to the evaluation of the qualifications and the project proposal, will be published, as soon as available, before the oral exam, on the website <https://www2.unimol.it/dottorato/> together with the call for the oral exam.

Any further communications will be promptly published on the University website in the section dedicated <https://www2.unimol.it/dottorato/> and will be valid for all purposes as notification and official convocation of the candidates, who therefore will not have to wait for further communications.



To take the oral exam, the candidate must present himself on the day and time indicated in the published calendar. For the purposes of identification for the oral test, **each candidate is required to identify himself, before the oral test begins, preferably showing the same identity document already sent in copy, as an attachment to the application form.** To take the oral exam, the candidate must present himself on the day and time indicated in the published calendar. In the case of an oral videoconference test (through the use exclusively of the Google Meet platform), the candidate must guarantee the possession of the hardware and software necessary to allow the videoconference connection and the use of a webcam to allow their identification to the Jury

The oral tests, even at a distance, are public and can be carried out in Italian or English.

The final score is given by the sum of the scores reported in the evaluation of the qualifications, the project proposal and the oral exam.

Art. 9 Rankings

At the end of the selection procedures, the Commission, on the basis of the votes obtained by each candidate in the individual exams, draws up a single and general ranking of merit, for admission to the PhD Course.

Thematic scholarships are placed on those that bind the assignees to carry out the doctoral activity on a specific research topic, as indicated in the doctoral card: in this case, during the selections, the candidate's suitability to carry out the aforementioned research will also be taken into consideration.

Candidates, who pass the admission tests and are winners of one of the positions in the announcement, are admitted to the Courses, according to the order established in the single and general merit ranking, up to the number of places put out to tender for each Doctoral Course. In this single and general ranking, the suitability for the above places will also be detailed.

The merit ranking for admission to the Doctoral Course with the relative score (expressed in hundredths), will be approved by Rector's Decree, having ascertained the regularity of the acts, and will be published [Albo Ufficiale di Ateneo on line](#) and on the website <https://www2.unimol.it/dottorato/>.

The same ranking will then be sent to INPS which will verify the condition of child or orphan of:

- registered with the unitary management of credit and social services;
- retired user of the Public Employees Management.

At the end of the verification, INPS will proceed with the publication of the ranking on the Institute's website.

With subsequent Rector's Decree, the winning candidate will be admitted to the PhD Course in Translational and Clinical Medicine.

There are no personal communications to the participants in the tests, except in the case of filling vacancies.

Following the renunciation, express or tacit, by winning candidates, the relative ranking will be scrolled for the assignment of places remaining free until the day before the beginning of the course, without prejudice to the constraints described above for reserved or restricted thematic positions. Any vacancies will then be assigned to those who hold a useful position in the merit ranking, which will be summoned by e-mail from the PhD Sector.

Art. 10 How to enroll in PhD Courses

From the day of publication of each ranking list on the University Register, the winners will have 3 (three) natural and consecutive days to complete their enrolment in the PhD Course, under penalty of forfeiture.

The registration application must be submitted via the web by accessing the [Student Portal](#) on the website <https://www2.unimol.it/>.

Candidates who do not complete their enrolment in accordance with the procedures and deadlines laid down in the measure approving the ranking list will be considered to have tacitly renounced their right to enroll in the Course.

Candidates with a qualification obtained abroad who have been admitted to a PhD course must enclose the following documents with their enrolment application:

- for qualifications obtained in non-EU countries: a copy, in Italian or English, of the first and second level qualification obtained abroad and of the certificate indicating the tests taken and the relative marks, with the relative translation and legalisation attached, and a declaration of value issued by the Italian diplomatic or consular representations or certificates of comparability and verification issued by ENIC_NARIC centres. The declaration of value must certify that the qualification held is valid in the country in which it was obtained for enrolment in an academic course similar to the PhD. If the declaration of value referred to above is not available by the date indicated, a document proving that the request for issue has been forwarded to the relevant diplomatic mission must be submitted.
- for qualifications obtained in EU countries: Diploma and Diploma Supplement in English for first and second level qualifications or comparability and verification certificates issued by ENIC_NARIC centres. The University reserves the right to request the Declaration of Eligibility also for qualifications obtained in EU countries.



Candidates in possession of a foreign qualification who do not show the documentation required at the time of enrolment are registered with reservation and must submit the documentation above within 60 days of enrolment, under penalty of blocking of the career and subsequent forfeiture, with the obligation to return any monthly scholarship payments received. This provision also applies if, following verification, the product title does not comply with the requirements of art.3.

ATTENTION: Non-EU citizens applying for visas must pre-register on the University portal <https://www.universitaly.it/index.php/dashboard> under "International students" to apply for an entry visa.

Enrolment is completed only upon issuance of the entry visa for study in Italy, which is the exclusive competence of the Italian Diplomatic Representations abroad, regardless of the suitability acquired.

Non-Italian citizens admitted with a scholarship must present, by the start date of the doctoral course, the tax code issued by the Italian Revenue Agency for the purpose of paying the scholarship.

Only non-EU citizens must also attach a valid residence permit, if already issued, or a copy of the request to the competent authorities within 8 working days of entry into Italy.

Art. 11 Tuition fees

With regard to tuition fees and relevant exemptions, please refer to the provisions of the [Regolamento in materia di contribuzione studentesca](#) for the academic year 2021/2022, to which reference should be made in full. Withdrawal or exclusion from the PhD course does not entitle the student to a refund of the fees and contributions paid.

Art. 12 Scholarships

The available scholarships will be awarded according to the order of the competition ranking.

All scholarships, financed by an external body, will be paid to the assignees subject to the actual collection by the University of the relative sums. The University assumes no responsibility for delays in the payment of scholarships financed by external bodies to the recipient candidates, in the event that such delays depend on causes attributable to the funding body.

The scholarships have an annual duration and, for the years following the first, must be renewed subject to admission to the following year by the Board of Teachers.

The scholarship starts from the beginning of the course or, in case of deferred start of attendance, from the actual beginning of the same.

Starting from 1 July 2022, the annual amount of the scholarship for attendance at PhD courses is set at € 16,243.00 gross of social security charges borne by the recipient, pursuant to Ministerial Decree no. 247 of 23 February 2022. The payment of the scholarship is made in deferred monthly installments.

The scholarship is granted exclusively to those who do not have, in the calendar year of use of the scholarship, a gross annual income exceeding the amount of an annual scholarship equal to € 16,243.00.

The PhD scholarship is subject to the payment of INPS social security contributions separately managed pursuant to art. 2, paragraph 26, of Law no. 335 of 8 August 1995 and subsequent amendments, to the extent of two thirds borne by the University of Molise and one third by the scholarship holder. PhD students enjoy the related protections and rights. The scholarship recipients must enroll in the separate INPS management.

The winners of the scholarships undertake, at the time of acceptance of the scholarship, not to exceed, for each year of enjoyment of the scholarship, this income limit, to the determination of which contribute income of patrimonial origin, as well as emoluments of any other nature, including those of an occasional nature. The income refers to the tax period relating to the calendar year of greatest use of the scholarship. The PhD student, holder of a scholarship, who exceeds the personal income limit, must return the monthly payments of the scholarship received in the year in which this exceedance occurred.

The scholarships cannot be combined with research grants or other scholarships for any reason awarded, except with those granted by national or foreign institutions useful to integrate, with stays abroad, the training or research activity of the PhD student.

The amount of the scholarship is increased, for the period of stay abroad ordinarily envisaged, to the extent of 50%, for a maximum period of 12 months, 18 in the case of co-supervision or doctorates in associated form.

The scholarship has an annual duration and is renewed, for each year of the course, provided that the doctoral student passes the test for the transition to the following year.

Those who have already benefited from a scholarship for the PhD in Italy cannot apply for a second time.

Starting from the first year, each PhD student is assured a budget for research activities in Italy and abroad, for an amount equal to 10% of the scholarship, in addition to the scholarship and within the financial resources existing in the budget of the subjects accredited to current legislation.

This budget is not provided for scholarship holders from foreign countries or beneficiaries of financial support under specific mobility programs in relation to the provisions of the specific regulation.



Art. 13

Rights and obligations of PhD students

Admission to the PhD involves an exclusive and full-time commitment, according to the procedures indicated by the Board of Professors, without prejudice to the provisions of paragraph 4 and referred to in Article 10, paragraph 2, letter b of D.M. 226/2021. For each PhD student it is ordinarily expected to carry out research and training activities, consistent with the doctoral project, at highly qualified institutions abroad (art. 12, paragraph 2 of DM 226/2021).

The acceptance of thematic scholarships necessarily implies the carrying out of periods of study and research in the locations specified in the registry of the relevant Doctoral Course chosen (to which reference should be made). The candidate, since the submission of the application for participation, is aware of the need to carry out, in case of assignment of the place, these mandatory periods in Italy and abroad, as indicated in the annex A and that failure to comply with this provision will result in the revocation of the scholarship: in this case the University of Molise may claim against the beneficiary for the return of the amounts received.

It is recalled that PhD students are obliged to respect:

- the obligations and constraints established by the Regulations of the PhD courses of the University of Molise, issued by Rector's Decree no. 256 of 10/03/2022;
- all the applicable rules and regulations of the University of Molise, including the discipline on student contribution established by the University.

In addition, the recipient of the scholarship within the resources referred to in DM 351 and 352 of 9 April 2022 will be required to report on the activities carried out every two months. Specifically, the reporting will take place through the appropriate online platform <http://dottorati.miur.it> and using the forms present therein: each PhD student will have to produce a report indicating the time commitment (divided into months in the company, at the headquarters, abroad, as planned) and a summary of the main activities carried out.

PhD students have the obligation to attend Doctoral Courses and to carry out all training, study and research activities in the structures intended for this purpose and according to the procedures established by the Board of Professors of the Doctoral Course.

PhD students carry out, as part of their training plan, activities aimed at ascertaining both the results of the research carried out and their exhibition skills according to the procedures established by the Board of Professors.

By the end of each academic year, the PhD student is required to submit to the Board of Professors a report regarding the research activity carried out and the results achieved, as well as any participation in seminars and congresses and other scientific initiatives, together with any publications produced. The positive evaluation by the Board of Teachers, reported on a special report, involves the passage of the PhD student to the following year.

Following registration, for institutional communications the PhD student is required to use the institutional e-mail box provided at the time of registration.

Further rights and obligations of PhD students are governed by art. 23 of the current University Regulations on PhD, to which reference is made.

Art. 14

Final exam and achievement of the title

For the application for admission to the final exam and for the achievement of the title of "PhD" reference is made to art. 34 of the current [University Regulations on PhD](#).

The title of PhD, abbreviated with the words: "Dr. Ric." or "Ph.D.", is issued following the positive evaluation of a thesis that highlights its originality and scientific relevance.

The Examination Commission, at the end of the discussion, with a motivated collegial judgment approves or rejects the thesis and with a unanimous vote, has the right to award the praise in the presence of results of particular scientific importance. The candidate who passes the final exam is awarded the title of PhD and is issued a diploma that shows the wording of the Doctoral Course and any curriculum attended.
